

NAME

`mrcrop-transaction` – crop Oracle extended SQL trace files using XCTEND lines

SYNOPSIS

```
mrcrop [ options ] transaction [ --end-time=date-time ] [ --help | -? ] [
--license ] [ --man ] [ --start-time=date-time ] [ --version ] [ file ... ]
```

DESCRIPTION

`mrcrop transaction` splits trace files when it encounters XCTEND lines. An XCTEND line indicates that the current transaction has ended. A transaction can end in either a commit or rollback.

OPTIONS

--end-time=*date-time* Exclude performance data for calls beginning after time *date-time*, an ISO 8601 combined date and time stamp. The default value is 9999-12-31T23:59:59, which means to include data through the end of the input file.

--help, -? Print usage information and exit.

--license Print license key information and exit.

--man Print the manual page and exit.

--start-time=*date-time* Exclude performance data for calls ending before time *date-time*, an ISO 8601 combined date and time stamp. The default value is 1970-01-01T00:00:00, which means to include data beginning on line 1.

--version Print the version number and exit.

EXAMPLES

Consider the following trace file:

```
$ nl f.trc
 1 ...
 2 XCTEND
 3 ...
 4 XCTEND
 5 ...
 6 XCTEND
 7 ...
```

The `transaction` subcommand would create these output files:

Command	Output files
<code>mrcrop transaction f.trc</code>	<code>f-1.trc</code> containing lines 1–2 <code>f-3.trc</code> containing lines 3–4 <code>f-5.trc</code> containing lines 5–6 <code>f-7.trc</code> containing line 7

EXIT STATUS

Exit status is 0 for success, 1 for failure.
